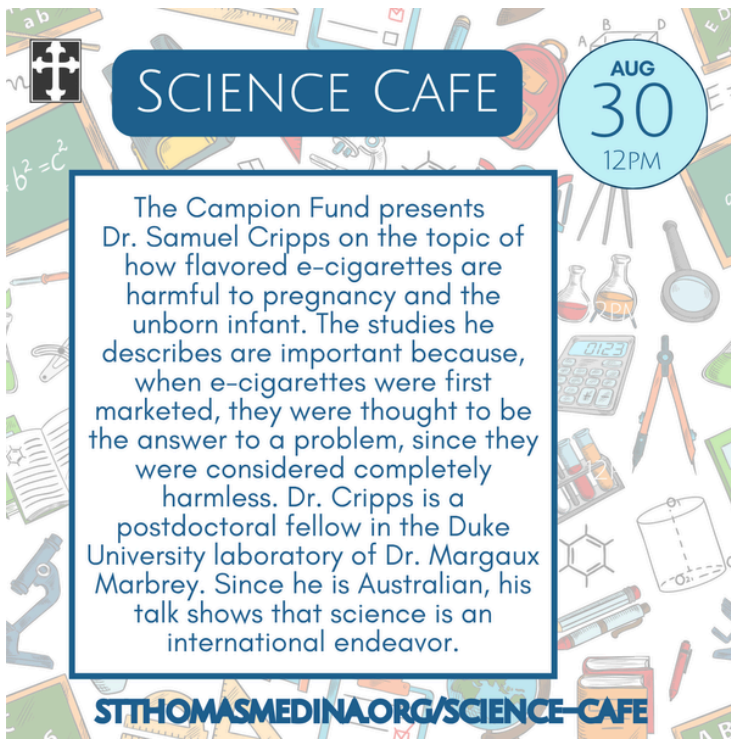

The Campion Fund presents Dr. Samuel Cripps on the topic of how flavored e-cigarettes are harmful to pregnancy and the unborn infant. The studies he describes are important because, when e-cigarettes were first marketed, they were thought to be the answer to a problem, since they were considered completely harmless. Dr. Cripps is a postdoctoral fellow in the Duke University laboratory of Dr. Margaux Marbre. Since he is Australian, his talk shows that science is an international endeavor.
