Join the Rev. Jim McEachran for a deep dive into the book of Ephesians. People familiar with the Bible and those new to it are welcome and encouraged!

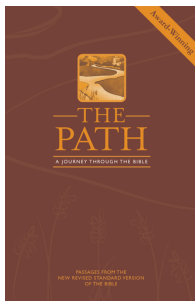
THE PATH
