For the 33rd year, St. Thomas will be hosting the Porchlight Rotating Shelter for the month of July!

To make a monetary donation to help pay for essentials, scan the QR code! You can also make checks payable to St. Thomas with "PL-RS or PLRS" in the memo line and mail to: St. Thomas Episcopal Church, P.O. Box 124, Medina, WA 98039 or place in Jean Waite's mailbox.



While the men stay at St. Thomas, volunteers are needed to cook dinners (either in their homes or the church's kitchen), then serve them! Signups will be available during Coffee Hour after some 8am and all 10am services beginning May 31. If you can't sign up during one of those times please contact Laurie Angelo, (425) 466-6892, laurie.angelo@outlook.com.

We will also need funds to cover breakfast and lunch, as well as cleaning, laundry, toiletries, and kitchen supplies. Donations of any amount are greatly appreciated!

\$35 provides a month of toiletries for 1 man

\$40 will buy a pillow, bath towel, and blanket for 1 man

\$75 will buy breakfast for 15 men

\$90 will buy lunch for 15 men

\$500 to the dental program

Eucharistic Visits are available for those unable to attend Sunday worship. During a visit, a trained lay Eucharistic Visitor or clergy person brings Holy Communion, offering a way to stay connected to St. Thomas. Visits can be made to homes, hospitals, rehabilitation centers, and care facilities, whether short-term or ongoing.

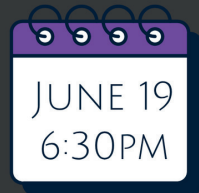
